Century Golf

In 2014, the Enterprise issued a Request for Proposal to golf management companies soliciting bids to manage the Talking Stick Golf Club. The golf management companies that responded included Troon Golf and Century Golf Partners/Arnold Palmer Golf Management ("Century Golf")." Century Golf was selected effective October 1, 2014, replacing Troon Golf. Century Golf is the current manager of Talking Stick Golf Club's two 18-hole golf courses, the Wildhorse Grille and employs a staff of 90 personnel.

The Enterprise wants patrons of the golf club to know that they are within the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community. The Enterprise directed Century Golf to increase Community and Native American employment; promote the Talking Stick brand; work closely with other Tribal enterprises and promote the culture and history of the Community.

October of 2014, Century Golf begins managing the Talking Stick Golf Club.



In <u>October 2014</u>, the Talking Stick Golf Card is introduced. The Card promotes the Talking Stick Golf brand and the Community. Over 1,200 cards are sold annually.
