**ORDINANCE NUMBER: SRO-593-2025** 

AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 15.1 OF THE SALT RIVER PIMA-MARICOPA INDIAN COMMUNITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES ADDING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1.0%) TAX ON PACKAGED ALCOHOL SALES TO PROMOTE YOUTH COMMUNITY HEALTH AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS, INCLUDING DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT.

Section 15.1-143 of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community Code of Ordinances is amended as follows, and shall now read:

## Sec. 15.1-143. Alcohol Tax.

In addition to all other taxes of this Community Code of Ordinances, the following taxes on alcoholic beverages are levied on the retailer and shall be collected by the collector for the purpose of raising revenue to be used in defraying the necessary expenses and obligations of the Community:

- (1) On each sealed container of spirituous liquor at the rate of \$3.00 per gallon and at a proportionate rate for any lesser or greater quantity than one gallon.
- (2) On each container of vinous liquor, except cider, of which the alcoholic content is not greater than 24 percent by volume at the rate of \$0.84 per gallon and at a proportionate rate for any lesser or greater quantity than one gallon.
- (3) On each container of vinous liquor of which the alcoholic content is greater than 24 percent by volume, \$0.25 for quantities less than eight ounces and an additional \$0.25 for each additional eight ounces (or fraction thereof).
- (4) On each gallon of malt liquor or cider, \$0.16, and at a proportionate rate for any lesser or greater quantity than one gallon.
- (5) A separate alcohol privilege tax of one percent (1.0%) shall be levied on those retailers who sell packaged liquor pursuant to Section 14-55(8) of this Code of Ordinances. The revenues generated from this separate packaged liquor tax are to supplement and support youth Community health and education programs, including projects related to drug and alcohol abuse prevention and treatment.

All collection, payment and enforcement (and other rules, deductions and exclusions) pursuant to this section shall apply as they apply to all standard transaction privilege taxes.

## $C_E_R_T_I_F_I_C_A_T_I_O_N$

This ordinance is hereby enacted pursuant to the authority contained in Article VII, Section 1(c)(1) of the Constitution of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community ratified by the Tribe on February 28, 1990, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on March 19, 1990, and amended by the Tribe on February 27, 1996, and approved by the Secretary on April 23, 1996, the foregoing ordinance was approved this 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2025, in a duly called meeting held by the Community Council in Salt River, Arizona, at which a quorum of 9 members was present, by a vote of 7 for; 2 opposed; 0 abstaining; and 0 excused.
