
Salt River Community Member Tax Exemption

The Salt River Indian Community (SRPMIC) operates like any other city/municipality, collecting taxes for public services.

- According to Arizona Taxpayer Ruling TPR-95-11, enrolled members of the SRPMIC do NOT pay Arizona state tax (TPT-currently at 6.3%) at this location on the SRPMIC.
- This state administered exemption only applies to State & County TPT. Community Members ARE still subject to the SRPMIC TPT rate of 1.75%.
- This exemption only applies to enrolled members of SRPMIC and NOT all Native American customers.
- Qualified customers need to complete
 the Arizona Form 5000 with their relevant
 information, including their Tribal ID# in
 Section C. They also check exemption
 #12 and sign the form. Your business may
 have a shorter streamlined version of this
 exemption form which can also be used.
- Enrolled members of the SRPMIC are aware that they can activate tax exemption by showing their tribal ID when making purchases within the SRPMIC.
- When a guest says, "Can I use my tribal ID?"
 or "Can I use my tax exempt?" they are asking
 for this policy to be implemented and are
 accustomed to presenting their tribal ID.
