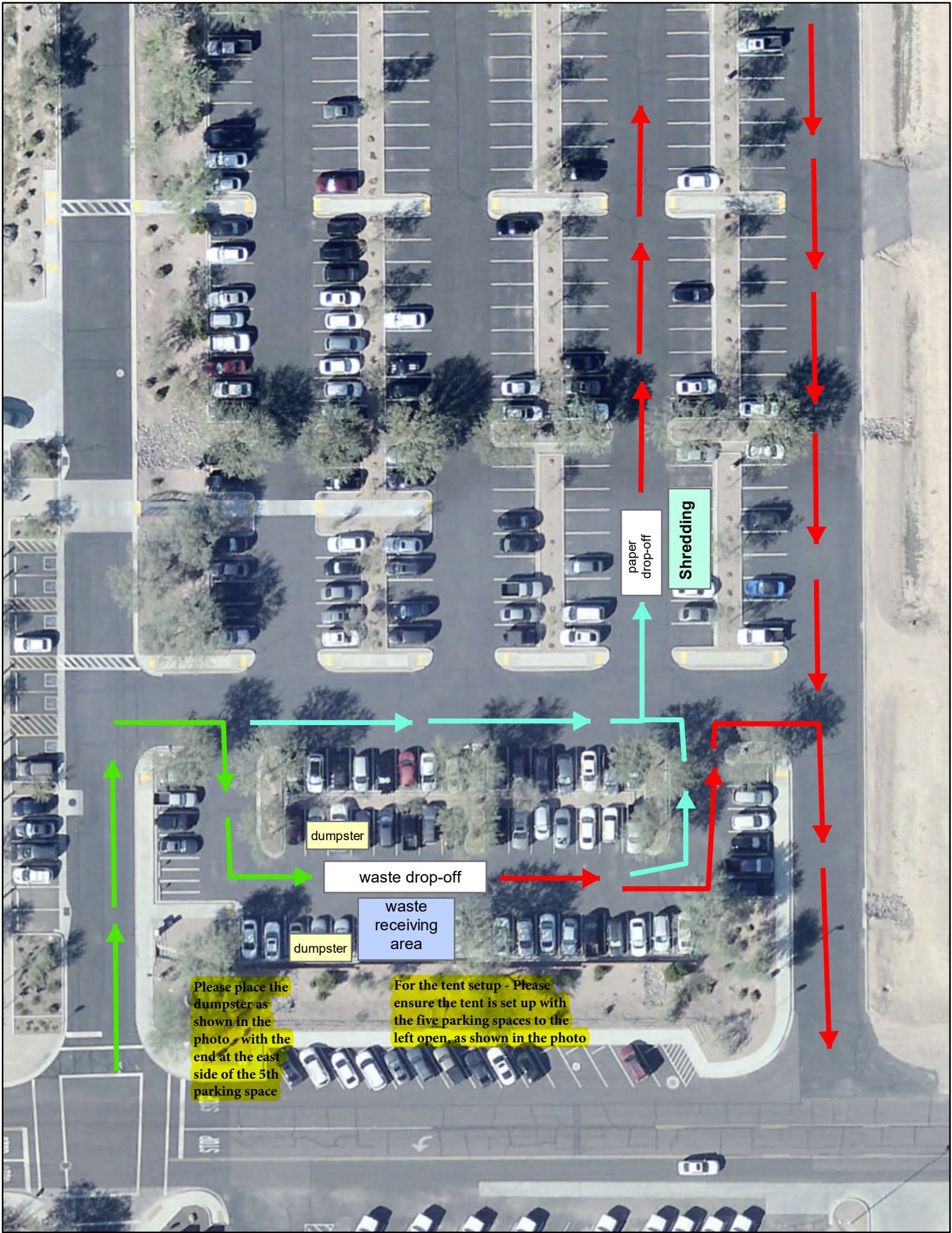
Two Waters North parking lot

Please remain in your vehicles when dropping off both household hazardous waste and paper for shredding to ensure safety of staff and other individuals dropping off items.

There is no limit on the amount of paper to shred. Please remove paper from 3-ring binders, comb binders, etc.

The Household Hazardous Waste event is for disposal of household wastes such as paints, cleaners, pesticides, herbicides, etc. There is a 5 waste tire maximum per household. Please note, we are unable to take any business or departmental hazardous wastes as it is illegal to dispose of generated hazardous waste as household hazardous waste.

The Sko Green: Trimming Emissions Initiative under the Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG) is helping SRPMIC residents reduce air pollution by replacing gas-powered lawn and garden equipment with cleaner electric or battery powered models.

- ✓ **Through the Sko Green program, eligible residents can receive:**
 - \$400 voucher for a new electric or battery-powered lawn mower
 - \$150 voucher for a new electric or battery-powered handheld device (like trimmers or blowers)
- ✓ **Sign up with us to schedule pick up of your old equipment or drop-off at the Household Hazardous Waste Event on October 25th from 7am - 1pm at North Parking Lot, 10005 East Osborn Road.**
- ✓ **Then receive your voucher and redeem at Home Depot!**

To qualify, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Live within SRPMIC boundaries
- Own working gas-powered lawn equipment
- Not have exceeded the 5-device per household limit
