

Starting at sunrise on Saturday, March 28, 2026 the Labriola National American Indian Data Center, an Indigenous Library at Arizona State University, is leading a Prayer Run to bless the Labriola Center and Indigenous support spaces at ASU Tempe Campus. The run is open to community members, and ASU Indigenous students, faculty, and staff. As an Indigenous led library, we believe running is medicine and intrinsically connected to many of our Indigenous cultures and traditions.

The Prayer Run begins at Sveg'i Do'ag (Red Mountain), continues to "A" Mountain, and ends at Moahdak Do'ag (South Mountain). As a relay, participants will run a distance and a pace that is comfortable for themselves.
