# Title VI Policy Statement

The Salt River Transit, a program of the Department of Transportation, Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community (“Community”), a federally recognized Indian tribal nation, assures compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights act of 1964 (“Title VI”), the Restoration Act of 1987, section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and the related statutes and regulations in its Demand Response Van Service, transit program. The purpose of this Title VI plan is to ensure that “no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination” under Salt River Transit’s program or activity.

Salt River Transit ensures that every effort will be made to prevent discrimination through the impacts of its programs, policies, and activities on minority and low-income populations. Furthermore, Salt River Transit will take reasonable steps to provide meaningful access to services for persons with Limited English Proficiency.

The Community has delegated the Title VI Officer or Program Coordinator to Rueben Malin, Director of Administration at the Community, to be the Title VI Civil Rights Officer to oversee and implement the Federal Transit Administration’s Title VI requirements.
