Governor

The Governor of Arizona serves as the state's chief executive and oversees the executive branch of government.



Enforces state laws and manages state agencies and departments



Proposes the state budget and sets policy priorities



Signs or vetoes legislation passed by the Arizona Legislature



Appoints leaders to boards, commissions, and agencies



Responds to emergencies and represents Arizona at the state and federal levels

Tribal Position

- ◆ First Governor to visit all Tribal Nations in Arizona
- ◆ Established MMIP Task Force when first elected to Office
- ◆ Raised the visibility of the Tribal Relations Office
- ◆ Consistently vetoed legislation that would impose more requirements to be able to vote

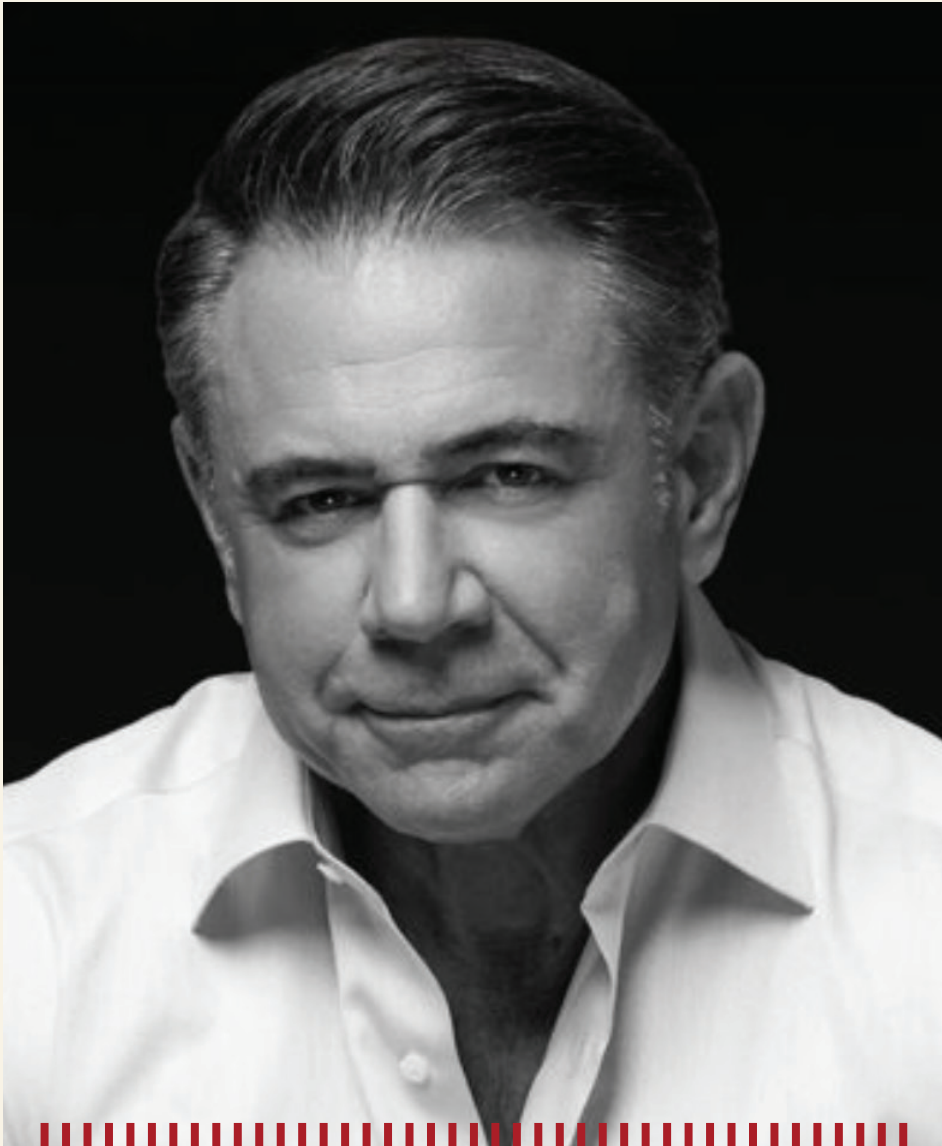
