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RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR REQUIRED CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION

(1) *CLE Hours Required Per Year.* Each admitted advocate shall complete three (3) hours of Continuing Legal Education (CLE) annually between July 1 and June 30.

(2) *Acceptable Content for CLE Courses.* In order for CLE credit to be approved, the CLE course must be relevant to legal practice within the SRPMIC. Relevancy of CLE courses is intentionally broad to provide maximum flexibility for the admitted advocate. If an admitted advocate has a question regarding whether a particular CLE course meets this standard, they should contact the admissions committee via email at AdmissionsCommittee@srpmic-nsn.gov.

(3) *Scope of Admission.* Pro Hac Vice admission, if granted, shall only be eligible for one (1) case. The expectation is that if a non-admitted advocate plans to appear as counsel for more than one case then the non-admitted advocate must proceed with the full admission process.

(4) *Affidavit of CLE Compliance.* An admitted advocate shall submit an affidavit of CLE Compliance annually by September 30. The affidavit may be submitted in person at the Community Court or via email at AdmissionsCommittee@srpmic-nsn.gov.

(5) *First Required Submission of CLE Compliance.* An admitted advocate is not required to submit an Affidavit of CLE Compliance until their first full year of admission from July 1 to June 30 of the following year. For those advocates who were admitted prior to January 1, 2025, the first Affidavit of CLE Compliance shall be submitted for the first full year following implementation of the Rules for the Regulation of the Practice of Law, which is July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026; the affidavit shall be submitted by September 30, 2026.

(6) *Professionalism Course.* Pursuant to Division 1, Rule V of the Rules for the Regulation of the Practice of Law, “The professionalism course must be completed within one year of admission, or for advocates already admitted on January 1, 2025, before January 1, 2027, with proof thereof provided to the committee.” CLE hours accrued in the professionalism course may count toward the CLE hours required per year. Proof of completion shall be provided on the CLE Compliance form submitted during the year the course is completed.

(6) *Carry-over CLE Credit.* There will be no opportunity to carry-over CLE credit for next year.
